The Global Gift Foundation's main objective is to combat social exclusion through the different programs. Its main purpose is the development, assistance and social inclusion of vulnerable groups particularly women and children at risk of social exclusion. Its activities aim to provide assistance by giving access to comprehensive health benefits, including those with disability & special needs giving empowerment to those who will benefit from these activities.

Social exclusion is a process characterized by being dynamic and goes through various stages. It refers to a loss of integration and participation of an individual within the society to which he belongs, including political, economic and community participation through their family and social network.

Until now, the concept of social exclusion has only been referred to in an economic sense (inequality and poverty), however, other areas that directly affect the political-administrative relationship must also be taken into account. This affects the individual when they have not had access to training or when there is an absence of participation within the social and political protection system and **their specific needs are not covered**. The socio-relational context is also affected when the individual doesn't have a job or is working in poor

conditions, or when they do not have a proper home or one that is not adapted to their special needs. In addition, their scarce social network, or belonging to an unstructured family can also result in a kind of social exclusion.

In order to develop social inclusion, Global Gift offers different programs and activities, some of their own and others are coordinated with external entities that work with different groups obtaining positive results by reaching a large number of people who are living in social exclusion or are at risk of falling into it,



WHAT IS CASA GLOBAL GIFT?

The Casa Global Gift is one of the main projects of the Global Gift Foundation. The idea was born out of the desire to cover the specific needs of children with special needs and / or rare diseases in the city of Marbella. These children are covered by Social Security, however, this does not cover all their specific needs, creating a lack of specialized and continuous attention that promotes their development. The Casa Global Gift aims to cover some of those needs in an integral way through the installation of a centre giving attention to children with special needs and rare diseases, by developing rehabilitation therapies for their proper development and improvement of their well-being and that of their family.

The Casa Global Gift will offer a space with facilities equipped with the ultimate innovations for 3 Marbella based Charities that have extensive experience in the care of different pathologies in children. Until now, these associations have lacked their own centre where they can offer therapies to their users, having to go to private centres bearing the high costs and often having to travel far several times a week to go to other organizations that offer the services they need.

The associations within the Casa Global Gift are:

Association **Bubbles and Dreams** (Association Bubbles and Dreams (children with rare diseases: Kabuki syndrome, mastocytosis, progressive spastic tetraparesis, genetic deletion on chromosome 7, bilateral hydronephrosis, mitochondrial disease, pituitary deficit).


- CADI Association (Cerebral Palsy, Down Syndrome, Autism, Spina Bifida, Intellectual Disability, Madurative or Development Delay, Crystal Bones).
- Cystic Fibrosis Association.


The Casa Global Gift will be facilitating the space and material equipment needed to carry out the therapies that these associations need, depending on each persons specific pathology, without incurring high costs for the families and minors involved. We are creating a centre, in a strategic and central point of the Costa del Sol facilitating travel from the following municipalities: Marbella, San Pedro, Estepona, Mijas, Fuengirola, Ojén, Coín, etc. To guarantee the greatest efficiency and results in the use of the Home, the Foundation opted to offer the space to 3 different Marbella based associations that collaborate with these groups and have sufficient experience in the approach and care of children with disabilities and / or rare diseases.

With this project, associations can have the space and resources necessary to best serve their patients and Global Gift can guarantee the proper use of the resources that this Home will offer through the professional experience of these associations.









CADI ASSOCIATION

The Association Centre for Attention to Children's Diversity (CADI), was created in November 2012 by a group of parents in reponse to the special needs of their children with functional diversity.

The main aims of the association are: to promote health research of any disability, contribute to the personal, cultural and human development of children with disabilities (with or without diagnosis) achieving social, school and work integration, promoting inclusion in ordinary classrooms, recesses and extra-school activities from an early age. In addition, they aim to promote greater involvement and participation of public and private entities, and of society in general, giving the children their fundamental rights. They provide help and support to the family through self-help groups and share all medical information with them.

The Casa Global Gift will give to this association a space that integrates the various therapies directed at child stimulation such as neurological physiotherapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, sensory integration, music therapy, therapeutic yoga, hydrotherapy, sensory play workshops, and educational programs for the parents, etc. Until now they have had to depend on other entities or associations to lend them a space and this often entails long distance travel for the parents. This House will provide them with improved coordination to attend all possible therapies with their own headquarters.

BUBBLES AND DREAMS

Bubbles and Dreams has two main purposes: therapies and research while providing support for the families and real integration of disability from childhood.

One of the objectives is to provide affected children with access to a series of therapies essential for maintaining or improving their condition, strengthening the capacities of the minors consequently boosting social integration. This association reserves 50% of their capacity for healthy children since, normally, a child suffering from a rare disease suffers from disabilities where their life is very limited by their condition. They spend most of their time in therapies where there are only other similar children, affected by a disability and gradually they move away from a normal environment. With this method, children with rare diseases participate with other healthy children who learn to interact with, and help children with special needs, developing empathy. On the other hand, the children with rare diseases receive stimulation from healthy children.

The Association offers traditional and / or alternative therapies, as well as different types of workshops aimed at the physical, intellectual and emotional stimulation of the children. In addition, they offer training and therapeutic workshops to the families of children with disabilities, giving the support and encouragement they need.

The Casa Global Gift will provide them with the space where they can set up their offices from where professionals can work and where they can perform food therapies, neurological physiotherapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, sensory integration, music therapy, therapeutic yoga, hydrotherapy, etc.





FIBROSIS QUÍSTICA

In March 1988 the **Cystic Fibrosis** association was created in Malaga with the aim of providing help, support, advice and collaboration to all those affected by cystic fibrosis and their relatives.

The objective of the association is to give adequate attention, training and educational welfare, labour and social services constituting comprehensive and planned actions. This ensures the patients receive the best care and protection, complementing these with the health care of the social security.

Currently they carry out social support activities, respiratory physiotherapy service, physio-osteopathy service, Pre and Post transplant support, seminars and courses as well as financial aid for families who have to move to transplant units in other cities such as Córdoba, La Coruña, Valencia, Madrid, etc.

The association has its Headquarters in Malaga and is already bearing the costs of patients in Marbella by using private medical installations, since the transfers to the headquarters in Malaga can be very expensive for families. That is why the **Casa Global Gift** will allow the association to open headquarters in Marbella where they can serve all patients in the area and nearby towns. In addition, the cost savings will allow the implementation of new personal trainer services, domestic support and family respite service, which is costly but very necessary to improve the life of patients with cystic fibrosis.





The Global Gift Home will be installed in a house owned by the municipality of Marbella that has granted its use to the Global Gift Foundation for a period of 30 years. The refurbishment for this centre will have high costs due to the specific characteristics that are needed, as well as the equipment, machinery and innovative elements required for child rehabilitation.

The centre will offer different areas in which to develop therapies and activities, combining basic and essential therapies with the most innovative and yet deficient in our country, Having all these activities take place in the same space will allow for optimum coordination between professionals, which in turn will mean greater progress in the development of each child.

Physiotherapy

In this treatment room motor skills will be worked on which of detrimental importance in the development of independence. Through the use of different materials, children develop motility throughout the body which alleviates the difficulties associated with the disability. Promoting movement and physical exercise also improves lung and respiratory capacity.



Sensory integration

In this room, children work the gross motor skills, the vestibular system and the proprioceptive system continuously improving and learning movements that promote autonomy. This room will be innovative in our region and will inspected and supported by specialist professionals and experts in sensory integration as well as development therapy.

Speech therapy

In this room, therapies will be offered that work on prevention, evaluation and therapeutic intervention in all disorders that affect voice, speech, language and swallowing.



Psychological care

Here we will offer diagnosis, evaluation and improvement of psychological development in children with disabilities and / or illness. At the same time, we will assist parents to improve acceptance and development techniques with their children.

Cooking

We will offer workshops and therapies with food. It is demonstrated that this type of activity improves fine motor skills and promotes healthy & creative eating in a fun way. Parents will also use this space for cookery workshops to learn how to prepare specific foods adapted to the needs of each child as a complement to the therapies they are receiving.



Cognitive training

Here we will conduct neurofeedback workshops. This is neurobehavioral treatment aimed at the development of self-control over certain patterns of brain activity and the application of these skills in the activities of daily life.

Multipurpose room

Multipurpose room, in order to organize lectures, conferences, seminars and other training for parents or professionals related to disability and rare diseases as well as boosting the knowledge that affects these users.




Office area

For the use of Global Gift Foundation as the main coordinator of the centre as well as giving each association an area to manage and administer their charities.

Hydrotherapy

Hydrotherapy is a form of physiotherapy and serves for the treatment of various diseases and disorders by stimulating the immune system, producing muscle relief, reducing stress and facilitate breathing.



Conference room

Conference room, where we will impart lectures, conferences, seminars and other training for parents or professionals related to disabilities and rare diseases as well as boosting and sharing knowledge & information that affects our patients.

Cystic fibrosis unit

We will have an Attention Unit for those affected by cystic fibrosis equipped with the latest innovative equipment & materials to help in the prevention of infections that affect Cystic Fibrosis sufferers such as: copper. Copper is a material with antimicrobial properties that eliminates up to 99% of bacterias that come in contact with its surface. 80% of the infections that affect these users are transmitted by contact, so with the installation of copper panels we will be able to avoid a high percentage of infection among those affected in order to carry out the necessary therapies to improve their health status.



Exteriors

Exterior areas where we will encourage physical activity, play and sports. In addition, children can participate in the cultivation and maintenance of several organic allotments. These type of activities are considered therapeutic because of their participation & contact with nature. This in turn will improve their physical, mental and emotional health of these children as well as reduce their stress & anxiety levels by encouraging their integration with the natural environment.



HOW WILL CASA GLOBAL GIFT FUNCTION?

The Casa Global Gift will function as a center for facilities for child rehabilitation and will offer administrative headquarters for associations that will use their space and equipment. The Global Gift Foundation will be responsible for bearing the costs of adaptation, maintenance and improvement of the facilities for the use of the children linked to each charity/association.

Each association can develop its own activities, manage its own users and volunteers through their programs in order to help the children with specific needs and / or rare diseases.

In addition to the individual therapies that children can receive, **Casa Global Gift** will serve as a reference centre to guide parents in the process of prognosis, treatment, development and control of the symptoms of each pathology. Through our contact with the different associations, we want to continue researching and developing new methods, techniques and therapies that can improve the quality of life of affected children and their families. We will develop conferences, meetings and specific workshops by experts in the fields related to the care of these pathologies.



HOW CAN I TAKE PART IN THIS PROJECT?
