

2. About Global Gift Foundation

The **Global Gift Foundation** is a social organization considered of public interest. It was founded by the actress, entrepreneur and philanthropist, **María Bravo**, in 2013. The objective was to create a positive impact on the lives of children, women and families who are in situations of vulnerability and / or at risk of social exclusion.

The **Global Gift Foundation** began supporting external charities, until the foundation grew, expanding its field of action and developing its own projects to meet its objectives.



OUR VISION

That all people can be fully integrated in the community in which they live, with all their basic and specific needs covered, whether social, medical, psychological, emotional or educational.



OUR MISSION

Create a positive impact on the lives of children, women and families who are in a situation of vulnerability and / or at risk of social exclusion.



OUR VALUES

Solidarity, commitment, equality, social justice, flexibility, humanity, unity (teamwork and collaboration with other organizations and charities to create synergies).



2.1 Targets and objectives of the Global Gift Foundation

The purposes of the Foundation include: cooperation for development, assistance and social inclusion of the most vulnerable groups, mainly children and young women at risk of social exclusion either for physical, social or cultural reasons.

Its principle activities are:

1. Cooperation with non-profit organizations dedicated to providing social assistance to these groups. The Foundation participates by offering financial aid in projects that provide education, culture, legal assistance, coverage of basic needs, help in finding a job and everything that facilitates the integration of these groups.

2. Carry out awareness campaigns to sensitize society to the risk and vulnerability situation of these two groups.

3. Collaborate in specific campaigns with non-profit organizations that work to achieve similar goals as those of the Foundation.

4. Cooperate in the financing and promotion of medical research projects that seek treatments for the cure or improvement in the quality of life of sick children and women, collaboration in specific vaccination campaigns, collaborating with non-profit entities in concrete moments. due to natural catastrophes, epidemics, etc.



5. Financial collaboration with charities that are dedicated to the opening of shelters, health centers, houses near hospital centers for relatives, etc.

6. The organization of all kinds of events and activities whose purpose is to raise funds, through donations, to support all the Foundation's programs and activities.

7. Provision of services and attention to users in need of assistance in matters such as speech therapy, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, sensory integration, stimulation, aimed for those with disabilities, diseases or other neurological and neuromotor disorders.

8. Carrying out and cooperating in leisure activities for these groups, such as giving workshops for therapeutic purposes, family respite or organizing camps and outings.

9. Promotion and participation in the training of volunteers, family members and professionals dedicated to caring for and helping the target groups of these services.

3. Annual Activity Summary

The Global Gift Foundation creates alliances with other charities as the main tool to achieve its objectives using collaborative and coordinated measures to achieve a greater impact of social improvement in the communities it helps.

During 2018 and 2019, the Global Gift Foundation has carried out a series of programs that are described below.





3.1 Program: Fundraising Events 2018 & 2019

In order to raise funds on a larger scale, María Bravo creates a model of exclusive charity events, which have become a worldwide reference.

These events are one of the main revenue streams of the Global Gift Foundation. Through the donations received during these events, the **Global Gift Foundation** supports the projects of other charitable organizations as well as creating it's own social and charitable projects.

These events are also the means through which shine we recognize the work carried out by other organizations, bringing awareness and media attention to the needs of their community, as well as rewarding the humanitarian, altruistic work of those striving to make the world a better place.

The events organized take place annually in each location and internationally. During 2018 and 2019 Global Gift Foundation held 18 events in 7 cities, thus collaborating with a total of 20 NGO´s.

Following the maxim of greater transparency and visibility of our work, we leave you a summary of the amount of donations delivered, as well as information about the projects carried out with said donations.

During the fiscal year 2018 and 2019, a total of **20 charities** have been supported by the Global Gift Foundation which are.



Fundación Querer

Amount Global Gift donated in 2018: 36,000€

Fundación Querer´s main objective is to help boys and girls suffering from rare diseases of neurological origin and their families in Spain through educational and medical support.

They created **"El Cole de Celia y Pepe"**, a comprehensive school specializing in children with delayed speech and language problems. Through this project, the Querer Foundation aims to respond to the educational needs of children with different rare diseases and disorders, helping the families who face these problems.

The **Global Gift Foundation** has been supporting the project of **El Cole de Celia and Pepe** since 2017, contributing necessary funds for the opening and equipping of the Center. Additionally, **Casa Global Gift and El Cole de Celia y Pepe** will collaborate by sharing information on cases of children with rare diseases in order to offer specialized and comprehensive intervention in each case.











Sunrise K Foundation

Amount Global Gift Donated in 2018: 40,370€

Sunrise K Foundation is a non-profit organization dedicated to raising awareness of childhood glaucoma, one of the leading causes of childhood blindness.

The mission of Sunrise K Foundation is to directly support research dedicated to finding a cure for debilitating diseases. It works hand in hand with the Eye Charity Foundation which supports the renowned Moorfield Eye Hospital and world renowned expert Professor Sir Peng Tee Khaw.













Help Refugees

Donated by Global Gift in 2019: 10,000€ 1,000 comidas a personas refugiadas.

Help Refugees was born in 2015 with the aim of providing support to refugees in Europe and the Middle East. Its core values are dignity, hope, respect and humanity.

It currently works in 10 different countries and supports a total of 80 local and grassroots projects, having helped more than 722,500 people through its projects in Europe and the Middle East.

The project supported by the **Global Gift Foundation** is located in Calais and Dunkerque, two areas located in the north of France. In these cities, they offer good quality food to displaced and vulnerable people living in the refugee camps of both cities. Through local teams, they have provided 1,000 hot, nutritious and culturally adapted meals on a daily basis through 4 distribution points.













Eva Longoria Foundation

Donated by Global Gift 2018 & 2019: 300,585.35€ N° of beneficiaries: 1,500

Founded by activist and actress **Eva Longoria** in 2012, the Foundation's primary mission is to foster the growth of Latina women and their families through education and business entrepreneurship.

Thanks to the great support that the **Eva Longoria Foundation** receives from Global Gift, in 2018 and 2019, the funds have been allocated to the following programs.

• STEM Education - Los Angeles: In 2018, ELF launched a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) education program where it worked with a group of approximately 40 Latina girls at a Los Angeles high school.

 Parental participation - Mexico City: Launched in different schools in Mexico City, helping 255 parents to graduate in 2018.

• Tutoring - Los Angeles, California: Tutoring support helps young Latinas to have contact with high-performing professional women by improving their self-confidence. 100% of the women who actively participated in these activities during their high school years attended University. In 2019, more than 200 women benefited from the program.

• Support for entrepreneurs - San José, California: Through the POSIBLE Latinas program in 2019, 1,000 women were advised with tools and resources to start or grow their small businesses.















Fredonia College Foundation

Donated by Global Gift in 2018: 21,344.36€

Fredonia University is a State University of New York, which, developed an interest in helping other students with fewer resources to also have access to opportunities for success, thus the Foundation was born. **Fredonia College Foundation** offers aid to students.

The support that this entity received from the Global Gift Foundation in 2018 was destined to the Helen Tinch Williams vocal performance program in which it offered to sponsor vocal artists with limited resources who are, or have been, students of Fredonia College.





Vipingo Village Foundation


Amount donated by Global Gift in 2018: 5,000€ N° of purchased meals: 10,350 N° beneficiaries: 140 children

Vipingo Village Foundation is located in the village of Vipingo, Kenya. Many of the children in this region are infected with HIV and do not have access to adequate education or health.

The foundation's goal is to offer different projects and resources to give these children a better future. They have a Montessori school that, in addition to education, offers two complete meals daily, nursing assistance and sport. In 2018, 140 children attended the centre.

The Vipingo Foundation has also worked on the recovery of 23 wells in the area for access to safe drinking water and has developed an adult literacy program.

Thanks to Vipingo's support from the **Global Gift Foundation** in 2018, they have been able to provide 345 daily meals for more than 5 months, a total of 10,350 meals for all these children, have been covered by our donation.













Unicef Francia

Donated by Global Gift in 2019: 10,000€ N° of Children sent to school: 571

The French headquarters of the world-renowned **Unicef** NGO works to defend the rights of minors in France and raise funds for international programmes they run.

The program supported by the **Global Gift Foundation** in 2019, aims to join the efforts of the government and education teams to provide an inclusive and quality educational curriculum in Lake Chad province.

Its purpose is to enable children in displaced, refugee and foster situations to improve their living conditions. It responds both to the urgency of the situation for displaced and fostered children in a humanitarian crisis, as well as to the rapid development requirements needed to enable communities to improve their standard of living and reduce the risk of children working with armed militia groups.

Throughout 2019 they have received 571 students through two training centers, 3 schools have been built in which more than 200 new students can participate, 500 teaching books have been purchased and many other actions have been undertaken.














CRIS contra el Cáncer

Donated by Global Gift in 2019: 24,607€

Cris Against Cancer is an association dedicated to research and support of cancer patients, focusing mainly on infant oncology projects.

Funding received by the **Global Gift Foundation** in 2019 was earmarked for the research project of the GPID, a brain-based cancer that leads to the loss of essential bodily functions such as breathing, balance, eye movement or heartbeat. It is currently not curable and affects children between the age of 4 and 11.

The team led by Dr. Jacques Grill of the Gustave Roussy Institute in France, is in charge of carrying out the research and finding a cure for all children suffering from this type of cancer.













Ronan Keating Foundation

Donated by Global Gift in 2018: 8,750€ Help given to 29,039 people 564 grants.

The **Ronan Keating Foundation** allocates all funds raised to the **Marie Keating Foundation** that aims to provide cancer services and information to all those who require it.

This foundation is the leader in providing cancer awareness in Ireland by distributing information on the different types of cancer through Mobile Information Units with 8 nurses moving to schools, workplaces and community centres. In 2018 they provided information to 29,039 people from 440 different locations. 564 grants were offered for patients with high medical expenses.















Rays of Sunshine

Global Gift donated in 2018: 114,041.09€ Childrens dreams come true: 5,988

Rays of Sunshine is a UK charity that grants the wishes of children between the age of 3 and 18 who suffer from a serious, life threatening illness.

Each dream is as unique as the child himself. And fulfilling them gives the child the opportunity to forget their illness and do something they have been dreaming about for a long time, making them feel special and giving them hope and happiness despite their situation. In addition, it offers families unique moments to remember.

Whether a boy or girl wants to be a princess or firefighter for a day, go to Disneyland, visit Santa Claus in Lapland, have an iPad or meet his favorite pop star, Rays of Sunshine works hard to make that wish come true.

Thanks to the support that this organization has received from the **Global Gift Foundation**, in 2018 the wishes of 5,988 children have been fulfilled.













Football for Peace

Global Gift donated in 2019: 63,188.57€ N° of beneficiaries: 1,700 people

Fooball for Peace, is a diplomatic sports movement that aims to combat the risk of young people from countries where they are incited to hatred for having different nationality, religious belief, ethnicity, age or gender and consequently are exposed to crimes of hatred, violence and radical ideologies.

Football is a tool that is uniquely positioned for transcending different nationalities, ethnicities, religion, age and gender, offering an alternative to division, violence and extremism.

During 2019, the organization has conducted an educational program that consists of empowering young people to become "Leaders for Peace", changing their attitudes and minds using different educational tools to challenge, unite and educate by creating safer and more peaceful communities, rejecting any ideology that promotes hatred with one another. All this through playing together, working with each other both off and on the field.

A total of 40 Peace Leaders have been trained, working with more than 1,000 young people from different areas, family members and their community.













Cesare Scariolo

Amount donated by Global Gift in 2018: 650€ N° beneficiaries: 16 families

The **Cesare Scariolo** Foundation is a private non-profit organization whose main objective is to help children with leukemia, lymphoma and other cancers, supporting families in situations of need derived from the disease itself.

Thanks to the participation of the **Global Gift Foundation** with the Cesare Scariolo Foundation in 2018, 6 families were helped through the housing program where families who needed hospital treatments and outpatient therapies at the Maternal Children's Hospital were provided with a place to stay. Often patients live far away and have no resources to afford accommodation throughout their treatments.

10 financial grants were also offered to alleviate the costs of the disease itself. In addition, the charity organized leisure activities for families with the aim of breaking the hospital routine.









Luis Fonsi La Perla Pinta su futuro

Donated by Global Gift in 2018: 87,600€

La Perla is a community located in the historic district of San Juan (Puerto Rico) that has a very important cultural richness due to its architectural heritage and history.

In mid-September 2017 Hurricane Maria swept through many of La Perla´s homes, including the most important historic building in the area called "Matadero".

This disaster left many neighbours without housing or resources and, coupled with the poverty that the neighborhood has always suffered, caused increased needs of all the inhabitants and their environment.

For this reason, the whole community is working to launch a project to rebuild this building that also serves as a cultural and historical center, together with a music room for children, sale of handicrafts and different shops to promote small businesses of the community.













Harmony House India

Donated by Global Gift in 2018 & 2019: 184,149.35€ N° beneficiaries: 150 children

Harmony House is an NGO located in Gurgaon, India, that intervenes and meets the needs of homeless children by taking care of all the important aspects for them through two community centers open to women and children.

In 2018, 150 children from the center have been sponsored by offering multiple services: daily nutritious meals,, education, hygiene products, regular medical reviews, training in vocational areas through workshops that seek to offer professional training, psychology sessions to improve self-esteem and scholarships to carry out higher education in other cities.

The **Global Gift Foundation** has been supporting Harmony House in all its programs since 2017, and at the end of 2018, Maria Bravo decided to visit one of the centers to see the work that its founders, Lucy Bruce and Gaurav Sinha do there. She was accompanied by some of the Global Gift ambassadors: Carlos Sobera, Patricia Santamaría, Sacha Jafri, Eva Longoria and Pepe Bastón who were able to enjoy a day with all the children of the center painting and laughing together.













Dubai Cares

Global Gift Foundation Donated to Dubai Cares 2018 & 2019: 153,961.88€ Food for 10,725 children. 550 children given education.

Dubai Cares is an organization that works to improve children's access to quality primary education in developing countries, creating and / or financing programs that can be integrated and sustainable in the community where they are implemented, understanding that Education goes beyond training. It is a tool to break the cycle of poverty.

Throughout 2018 and 2019 they have offered access to education and food distribution to refugee children and their families, they have taken on schools in: Cambodia, Malawi, Nepal, Palestine and Senegal with a total of 550 students, as well as financing new structures and school materials. Dubai Cares also focus on developing adult literacy.

All these activities have fueled the desire of Dubai Cares and the **Global Gift Foundation** to fight for children's rights to a good education to give a positive impact on their lives and those of their communities. Thanks to all these efforts over the years, more than 18 million beneficiaries have been reached in 53 different countries.











Quang Chau Foundation Orphanage Vietnam

Global Gift Donated in 2018: 6,200€ Number of beneficiaries: 100 children

The **Quang Chau Temple Foundation** is a non-profit organization that welcomes homeless children who have been abandoned to its orphanage, offering them food, medical care, education and everything they need for their basic needs.

María Bravo, visited the orphanage with the aim of offering her support to these little ones. She was accompanied by the international singer Luis Fonsi. Together, they joined forces and supplied the orphanage with beds, milk, diapers, food, educational materials and other supplies, covering the basic nutritional, educational and health needs of some 100 children.




La Fundación Angela Navarro

Donated by Global Gift in 2018::5,000€

The main objective of this foundation is to offer training and assistance to improve the aesthetics of people who have suffered an illness or treatment.

In 2018, with the contribution of **Global Gift Foundation**, they restored 3 wigs, donated 250 buff-type handkerchiefs to include them in specific kits for adolescent patients, held 18 workshops with specialists in skin care and hair prostheses, and developed other training workshops for 40 healthcare professionals on aesthetic solutions to alleviate the side effects of chemotherapy and radiotherapy treatments.













La Asociación Esclerosis Múltiple

Donated by Global Gift 2018 & 2019: 6,000€ Beneficiaries: 67

This association helps people with multiple sclerosis and other neurodegenerative diseases in the city of Marbella, offering physiotherapeutic, social and psychological support.

Thanks to the donations the Association received from **Global Gift Foundation** in 2018 and 2019, they were able to carry out their physiotherapy service, helping a total of 67 patients who received help to achieve the highest degree of independence possible. Physiotherapy is offered in the gym and at home, for those who cannot travel.

The Global Gift Foundation has been supporting this association since 2014 to allow them to continue offering support to those suffering from Multiple Sclerosis.

Asociación Debra-Piel de Mariposa

Amount donated by Global Gift in 2019: 2,000€ Number of beneficiaries: 534

The **DEBRA-Butterfly Skin Association** is a national non-profit organization, founded in 1993 in Marbella by people affected by Butterfly Skin such as family members, social-health professionals and collaborators.

The **Global Gift Foundation** collaborated with the "Bien Estar" program in which social workers, psychologists and nurses offer information services, socio-sanitary orientation and psychological support to affected people and their families. In 2019 they have attended a total of 534 people and 1,368 demands related to schooling, medical supplies, family assistance.









3.3 Program: Social Inclusion and Promoting Health

The main purpose of this program is to offer aid to people who are in a situation of vulnerability or at risk of social exclusion.

One of **Global Gift Foundation**'s own projects, it has been developed and managed through a professional assessment and intervention team. These grants are mainly intended to cover costs related to health expenses (operations, therapies, medicines or medical visits) and others related to covering basic needs (housing, food or bills).







Total amount donated by Global Gift Foundation: 5,851.25€

BENEFITED PROJECTS

In 2018 a total of 5 cases were supported in regards to medical expenses:

• Two cases were supported by covering costs relating to housing and food expenses.

• The remainder of the cases were children and were expenses related to health services such as specialist appointments, rehabilitation and therapies.



Total amount donated by Global Gift Foundation: 79,477.96€

BENEFITED PROJECTS

In 2019 9 cases were supported in regards to medical expenses, food and housing costs:

• Two cases were related to medical expenses, pharmacological treatments, rehabilitation therapies and the acquisition of orthopedic material.

• Four cases were related to assistance in payment of housing and food.

Below we have details of the last three cases: one of acquisition of prosthetic hands and feet and two with surgical interventions:



Olga Sharipo

Olga is a 12-year-old girl who lives in Malaga with her family. Olga has been affected by a facial macrocystic vascular malformation. This malformation, known as a lymphagioma, causes Olga multiple ailments. Olga's parents contacted our Foundation requesting help to operate on the little girl in December 2018. Thanks to Global Gift Foundation, Olga began her treatment and had her first operation. She is currently in treatment and the Foundation continues to support her in all the needs that may arise for her and her family.



Khatira Sarwari

The latest action was the operation performed was on **Khatira**, a 13-year-old Afghan girl diagnosed with end-stage renal failure and, although she was on dialysis, her condition worsened.

Her mother, Shafiqa Sarwari, is a single mother who lost her husband to a suicide attack. She had to stop working to care for her daughter full time. The only hope for Khatira was a kidney transplant, with her mother as the compatible donor.

When **Maria Bravo** received this request for help, she put all her efforts in raising the funds for the operation that would save **Khatira's** life. Everything went well and after the operation, Maria traveled to India, as she wanted to meet Khatira and her mother, in the process of recovery. Unfortunately, some time later, Khatira became ill again and passed away.



Sarah Almagro

We have also supported a young girl called **Sarah Almagro.** In her case for the acquisition of prosthetic hands and feet, a 20-year-old young woman from Marbella, an innate athlete and exemplary student.

On July 23, 2018, Sarah contracted meningococcus that led to septicemia and multiple organ collapse. In critical condition, the doctors managed to save her life, although to do so they had to amputate her hands and feet.

Her family and her friends started the campaign, "We are your Wave", with the aim of raising funds so that **Sarah** could have prostheses with which she could lead a life as normal as possible. Global Gift wanted to support this collection.

Currently, **Sarah** is learning how to use the new prostheses that will allow her to lead a normal life, studying, playing sports and recovering her life.



3.4 Program: Casa Global Gift



3.4.1

Global Gift Foundation's Key Project

The president of the Foundation, **María Bravo**, had a dream of creating a space where children with special needs and rare diseases and their families could have a home where they could receive therapies and treatments, hence The **Casa Global Gift** project was born.

Over time, this dream became a reality, taking the form of a Center for the care of disabilities, rare diseases and disorders suffered by children in the city of Marbella and Spain.

The objective of the project is to offer a space to carry out therapeutic activities in Marbella and thus alleviate the difficulties that parents encounter when having to pay the high costs of private rehabilitation and travel enabling the child to receive specific therapies for their pathology.

In addition, the project will incubate local associations and charities that don't have their own space. This networking allows the associations to continue their work in support of these groups by offering them headquarters where they can carry out their activities in a comprehensive manner.

Although the works of the **Casa Global Gift** have not finished, we have been conducting children's workshops and rehabilitation therapies in other spaces:



Painting Workshop: where the children, parents, volunteers and the Foundation staff enjoyed a morning of conviviality where they could express themselves through drawing and art. Together they drew a mural of gratitude to the Foundation and participated in different outdoor games.

• **Special Yoga:** With yoga teacher Laura Marro from "My Special Yoga" and the participation of 6 children with their mothers, a very special afternoon was enjoyed in which the children remembered the importance of taking care of themselves and feeling well. Special thanks to the Radiant Yoga Center for giving us their beautiful room to do the workshop.

• **Children's art therapy:** During a fun session, 10 children were able to learn to express their emotions and physical state through art and games.

• **Teen art therapy:** 8 teenagers participated and enjoyed a morning with their friends expressing themselves as they are and putting aside fears and complexes through art.

• **Music therapy:** 11 children enjoyed a morning together laughing and learning to play different instruments, singing and dancing with teacher Laura Andrade in a space provided by the Marbella town hall.

• **Painting workshop:** 12 children spent a morning of laughter and games through paintings related to the marine world. Patricio Moreno was the artist in charge of guiding the session in a room provided by the "Manolo Santana Racquets Club" Sports Center.

• **Cooking workshop:** 9 children participated in an activity where they stimulated their senses through food, touching, smelling, tasting and cooking with healthy foods. Thanks to Casa Skulp (physiotherapy center) for giving us the space.

• **Christmas workshop:** Professor Patricia Llavero organized different fun arts & crafts for the workshop where 7 children participated in a space provided by the town hall.

• **Casa Global Gift Presentation:** On July 12th, 2019 we took the opportunity to show the progress of the work to all our collaborators and Global Gifters during the Marbella Philanthropic Weekend. The children and families of the Global Gift House attended and participated in different activities organized together with the AVOI Association. In addition to these workshops, Global Gift Foundation is preparing the following services:

• **Physiotherapy room:** the fundamental objective of physiotherapy is the evaluation and treatment of motor function to achieve the greatest functional potential and autonomy.

Through different state-of-the-art machines, minors can develop the mobility of the whole body to alleviate the difficulties associated with disability, helping with movement and promoting physical exercise that improves lung and respiratory capacity.

• Sensory integration room: In this room, children work on gross motor skills, the vestibular system and the proprioceptive system, helping them to learn movements that promote autonomy. This room is the only one of its kind in our region, and will be reviewed and supported by different unique professionals and experts in sensory integration as developmental therapy.

• **Speech therapy room:** where the speech therapist will be in charge of evaluating, rehabilitating and preventing language, speech, voice and swallowing disorders.

• **Multipurpose room** where innovative therapies such as neurofeedback or music therapy are developed and practiced.

• **Cystic Fibrosis Unit:** We will have a specific unit for the care of those affected by cystic fibrosis equipped with the latest technologies that help prevent infections that can affect their disease. Copper is a material with antimicrobial properties that kills up to 99% of bacteria that come into contact with its surface. 80% of the infections that affect these users are transmitted by contact, so with the installation of these panels we will be able to avoid a high percentage of contagion among those affected, enabling us to carry out the necessary therapies to improve their health

• **Outdoors:** There will be areas where we will be able to organize physical activity, games and sports. In addition, boys and girls will be able to participate in the cultivation and maintenance of various organic allotments. These types of activities are considered therapeutic because contact with nature improves the physical, mental and emotional health of minors, working on aspects such as stress, anxiety through integration with the natural environment.

• Therapeutic pool for hydrotherapy: Hydrotherapy is a form of physical therapy and is used for the treatment of various diseases and disorders, as it stimulates the immune system, produces muscle relief, reduces stress and facilitates breathing.

3.4.2


